
Counter Top Unit

The water bath area is under the lid. You must fill the water bath with tap water, to the top of the standpipe, (white pipe in front of water bath), the water will be about 3/4" from the top of the unit. Yes, all that stuff ends up under water.

This will require about 3 gallons of water. Do not turn the refrigeration unit on without water in the water bath. This is where the unit makes a block of ice that is used to cool the drinks.

*** This water is only used for cooling the drinks, and you will never drink this water. From time to time check water level, and fill if low.



The incoming water, syrup, CO2 gas, and electric lines all come out of the unit behind the "Valve Plate", in the center.
You can drill a hole in the counter top, and bring lines straight down, or tuck them under the unit, going straight back.
You can raise the glides to keep from getting the lines kinked.

** Connect all lines and turn water supply on, BEFORE you turn the power switch to the "ON" position.
