Bag in Box fittings: Quick Connect, Disconnect (QCD)





There are two common types of connectors for Bag-in-Box syrup. The red one is for Coca-Cola and Coca-Cola brand products and the grey is for Pepsi and most other flavors including <u>WILLTEC At Home Soda</u>, and generics. If you plan on only using one type of bag as one of your flavors, you only need to use <u>one</u> connector. If it is a flavor that you plan on swapping to different brands of flavors, you can install both.

For Coke fittings use the one eared clamp to attach the connector to the end of the clear tubing. (1) Be sure to CRIMP the ear on the clamp.

For Pepsi style fittings, use the one eared clamp to attach the connector to the end of the clear tubing, and make sure to use the <u>Brown cap</u> to cover the other barbed end of the connector.(2)Be sure to CRIMP the Ear on the clamp

To use both connectors, connect the coke one first, then cut the clear tubing about 6 inches from the end. Install the Pepsi fitting using both barbed ends to each side of the cut clear tubing, and CRIMP a clamp on both sides. (3)
